



This document describes the Housing Finance Agency (HFA) Hardest-Hit Fund (HHF) data that state HFAs are required to provide to the U.S. Department of the Treasury. It includes quarterly borrower characteristic data and program specific performance data. All HFA HHF data submitted to the U.S. Department of the Treasury must be accurate, complete, and in agreement with retained HFA records. Data should be reported by each state HFA by the 45th day following the quarter.

Data requested in the "Borrower Characteristic" worksheet should be reported in aggregate for all HHF programs run by the state HFA. Program specific data is separated into reporting tabs for each individual program. State HFAs should report program performance data on an individual program basis. A data dictionary has been provided to assist in the definition of each data point.

Lines 1,8: Since applications marked as denied or withdrawn in previous quarters may be reconsidered due to a change in borrower circumstances, some unique borrower counts may not sum in a quarter-over-quarter fashion. This quarter **64** denied and **49** withdrawn cases were reconsidered. Also the receipt of \$285,000 from 19 Down Payment Assistance loans repurchased by lenders in prior quarters was reclassified from program income to return of grant. This reduced the cumulative column of Number of Unique Borrowers Receiving Assistance by 19 borrowers, but did not affect the QTD column. Cumulative Total Assistance Provided to date was decreased by \$285,000, but QTD amount was not changed. This change also decreased Guilford and Mecklenburg Counties counts by 4 and 15 respectively. The \$285,000 reclassification will cause Total Assistance Provided and some county totals to not sum in a quarter-over-quarter fashion.

Lines 126-131 & 142-147: Borrower can choose more than one Race designation, so total may not equal Total Borrowers Receiving Assistance, Line 2.

Lines 120-127 and 136-143. Ethnicity and Sex information was added this quarter for the Down Payment Assistance program. This increased only the culmulative column for the following rows. Borrower: Hispanic 443, Not Hispanic 3,260, Male 1,889, Female 2,047 Co-borrower Hispanic 54, Not Hispanic 314, Male 279 and 115 Female. These increases were offset by reductions in Information Not Provided by Borrower.
